


## Chippewa Secondary School





Dear Parents, Guardians, and Caregivers:

The OSSLT measures whether students are meeting the minimum standard for literacy across all subjects up to the end of Grade 9. Successful completion of the literacy test is one of the requirements to earn an Ontario Secondary School Diploma.

EQAO will continue to use a computer-based assessment that comprises two sessions (Session A and Session B) containing a total of 33 questions: 31 multiple-choice questions and two constructed open-response questions.

Grade 10 students will be attempting the OSSLT during the spring session (March 23 – April 20, 2025).
