

Extended French Certificate Program Pathway/ Le Certificat de Français Intensif à West Ferris Secondary School

The Extended French program is one in which not only French Language Arts but other subjects are taught in French. The principle aim of the Extended French program is to develop students' ability to communicate fluently and correctly in both oral and written French. This program helps foster the effective use of the language and the clear presentation of ideas across the total curriculum. Each year, students take a course in French Language Arts and they are encouraged to take at least one other complete subject in which French is the language of instruction.

Requirements for the Extended Certificate

Extended French Certificate students must complete 7 Extended French courses from the list above, including all four French Language courses (FEF). Many of these courses also fulfill compulsory credit requirements for the OSSD (Secondary School Diploma).

It is highly recommended that students take as many courses in Grades 9 and 10 in French as they can. This helps to facilitate their language development and ensures students have flexibility in their senior grades to take pre-requisite courses for college or university.
