Requirements for the Immersion Certificate

French Immersion Certificate students must complete 10 French Immersion courses from the list above including all four French Language courses (FIF). Many of these courses also fulfill compulsory credit requirements for the OSSD (Secondary School Diploma).

Planning Ahead

It is highly recommended that students take as many courses in Grades 9 and 10 in French as they can. This helps to facilitate their language development and ensures students have flexibility in their senior grades to take prerequisite courses for college or university.
