



Program/Student Success

- provides opportunity for broader course selection options.
- provides opportunity for specialty program access for more students ie. SHSM
- 5 period for Secondary to reflect flexibility in scheduling (maintain MSIP)
- NEW BUILD

IF proper staffing if provided, than appropriate support will be available for a wide range of students who require assisted learning opportunities (ie. Students with IEP's)

Building Structure

- 1 campus structure with 2 academic wings on one site (7-8, 9 – 12)
- connected through common courtyard, cafeteria and main office/foyer
- suggest separate gym, for each academic wing (7-8 double gym, 9-12 triple gym)
- suggest location West Ferris Site 1) Lot size accommodates current and future enrolment
2) Maintains and improves the culture of the West Ferris end of North Bay 3) Provides transportation solutions and opportunity due to multiple entrance points and accessibility to highway routes.
- Athletic facilities shared

Considerations

- Access to multiple athletic/extra curricular/social (LGBTQ, 'fringe kids' etc.)
- Recommended facilities such as the gymnasium and theatre allow for public separate access for community use purposes.
- 7/8 academic wing separate from the 9/12 academic wing addresses concerns parents may have about having a school with 2200 + students, including the concerns around social influences and ability to identify individual student needs.
- Administration needs to reflect 2 definitive separate teams, Elementary and Secondary, with the appropriate secretarial support
- If the appropriate facilities are not provided in this model, than the program delivery may be substandard (Theatre, Gym, Fine Arts Studios, Tech Rooms etc)

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
