

Cooperative Education

Before you register, please read the following carefully.

1. Prior to their placements, all cooperative education students must demonstrate an understanding of the pre-placement orientation expectations. Pre-placement orientation requires students to attend mandatory in class components.
2. Students who have earned cooperative education credits in the past are still required to prepare for new placements through the pre-placement orientation sessions.
3. Only courses with sufficient enrollment will run this semester.
4. You will be notified by email of any course cancellations. Otherwise, please plan to attend on the first evening of the course.
5. If you are attending day school you must obtain permission from the school principal or guidance counselor in order to take a continuing education course.
6. If you are attending day school, marks will be sent to the school. However, you are responsible to verify whether the course and mark have been added to your transcript.
7. If you are out of school, you are responsible to bring your Report Card to the school you last attended and have the mark added to your transcript.

Course Description:

Cooperative education courses include a classroom component, comprised of pre-placement and integration activities, and a placement component. Students earn cooperative education credits by integrating classroom theory with authentic learning experiences in the community to demonstrate their knowledge and understanding of the related curriculum expectations. Placements will provide students with challenging opportunities to apply and extend the knowledge, and practice and refine the skills, acquired in the related course and to demonstrate achievement of placement expectations that reflect current workplace practices and standards.

Students working to complete the experiential learning requirements for the SHSM diploma may wish to consider attending coop at *Night School or Summer School*.

Cooperative Education

Cooperative Education provides opportunities for students to explore a career. Through their work placements students will develop their employability skills and knowledge while obtaining secondary school credits. Night School & Summer School Cooperative Education provides the opportunity to earn one or two credits.

The Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program (OYAP) gives students the opportunity to earn cooperative education credits, gain experience in the skilled trades and in some cases, register as an apprentice while meeting diploma requirements for their Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD).
