

1. **Chippewa site:** New build or refurbish Chippewa to be a “super” school that will house all Grade 9-12 students.

School must have the following:

- Theatre + separate Dance Studio
- Triple Gym
- A covered, multi-purpose turf field
- Building Construction shop
- An Automotive shop
- A Welding shop
- An industrial kitchen for hospitality courses
- Office space for health/mental health workers
- Student Success centre
- Resource centre
- Learning commons area

New secondary school must offer the following programs:

- IB
- French Immersion
- STEAM
- Arts Nipissing

2. **Close West Ferris** and move West Ferris Grade 7 and 8 students to Silver Birches. **Silver Birches would be a JK-8 school.**

3. **Close E.W. Norman, E.T. Carmichael, and W.J. Fricker** and create a **JK-Grade 8 school at the W.J. Fricker site.** School could either be a new build or a renovation of the existing building.

Suggestion for another ARC review

4. **Close Alliance** and create a **JK-Grade 8 French Immersion** centre at the Widdifield site. This could be **done under a separate ARC process.** **NOTE:** Closure of Alliance would **alleviate a significant amount of the traffic problems** around the Chippewa site as well as the space issue at the present Alliance site.
