

Review of Two Grade 7-12 School Scenarios

First Scenario: Program Change

- Move grade 7 to 12 Extended French and French Immersion to West Ferris from Chippewa
- Move grade 7 and 8 Regular Program from W.J. Fricker to Chippewa
- Move grade 9 to 12 Regular Program from Widdifield to Chippewa

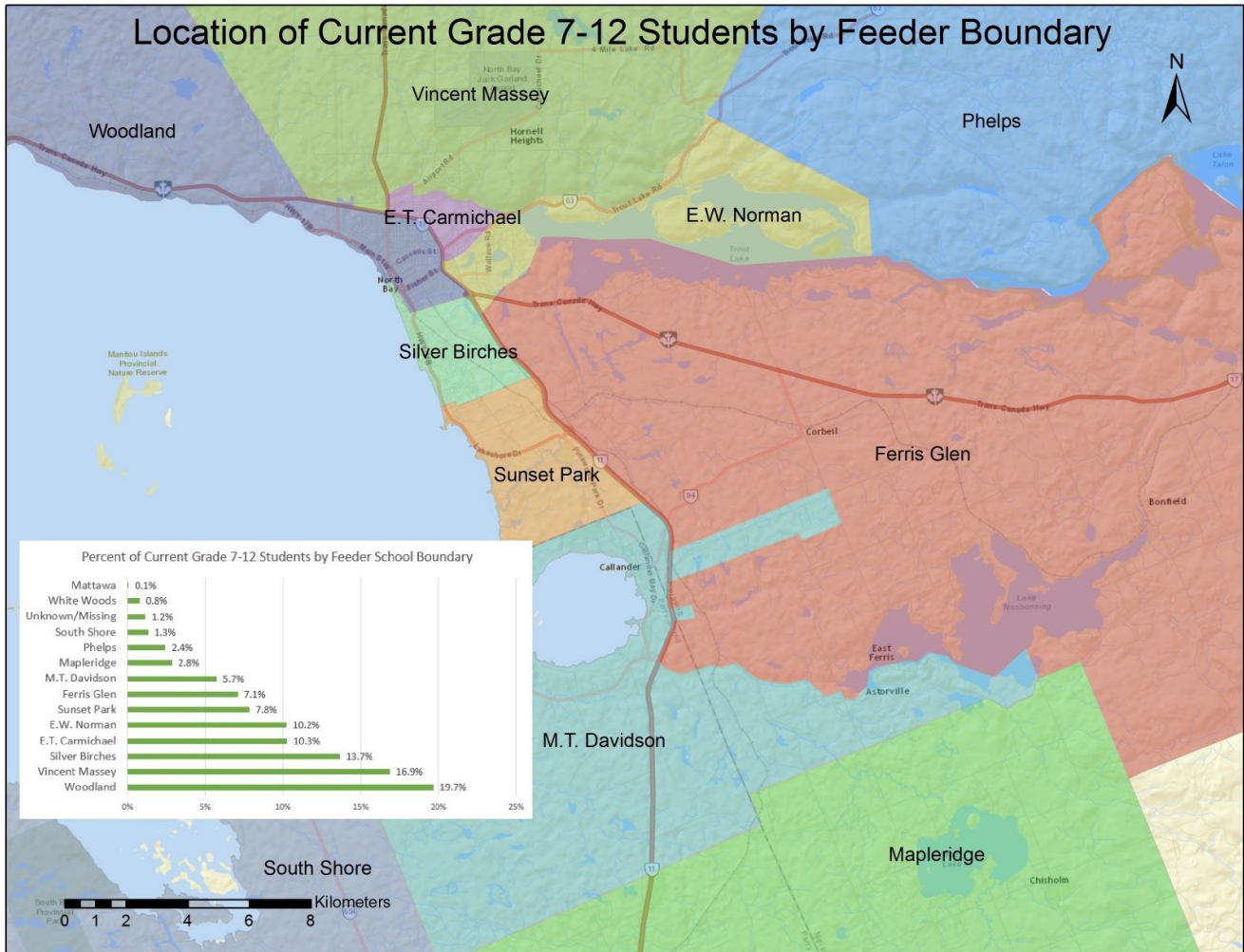

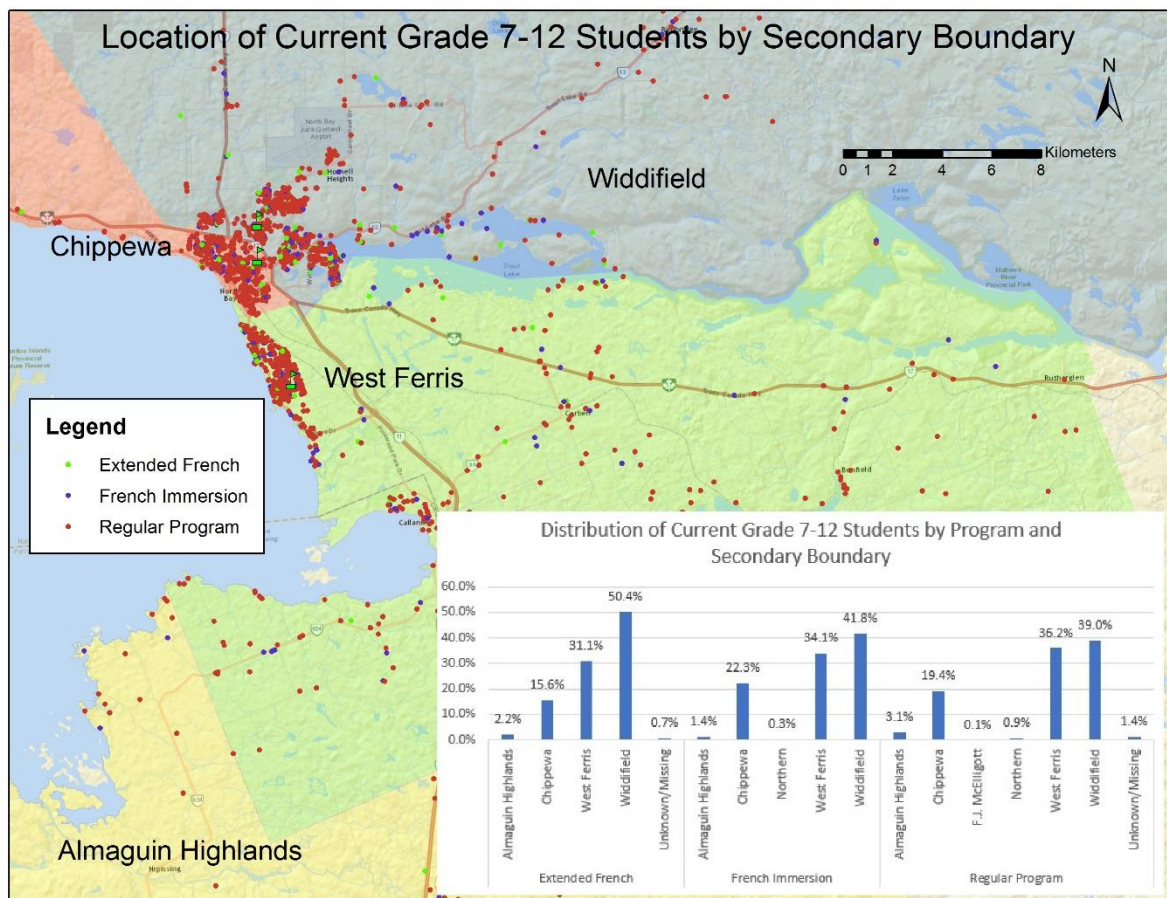
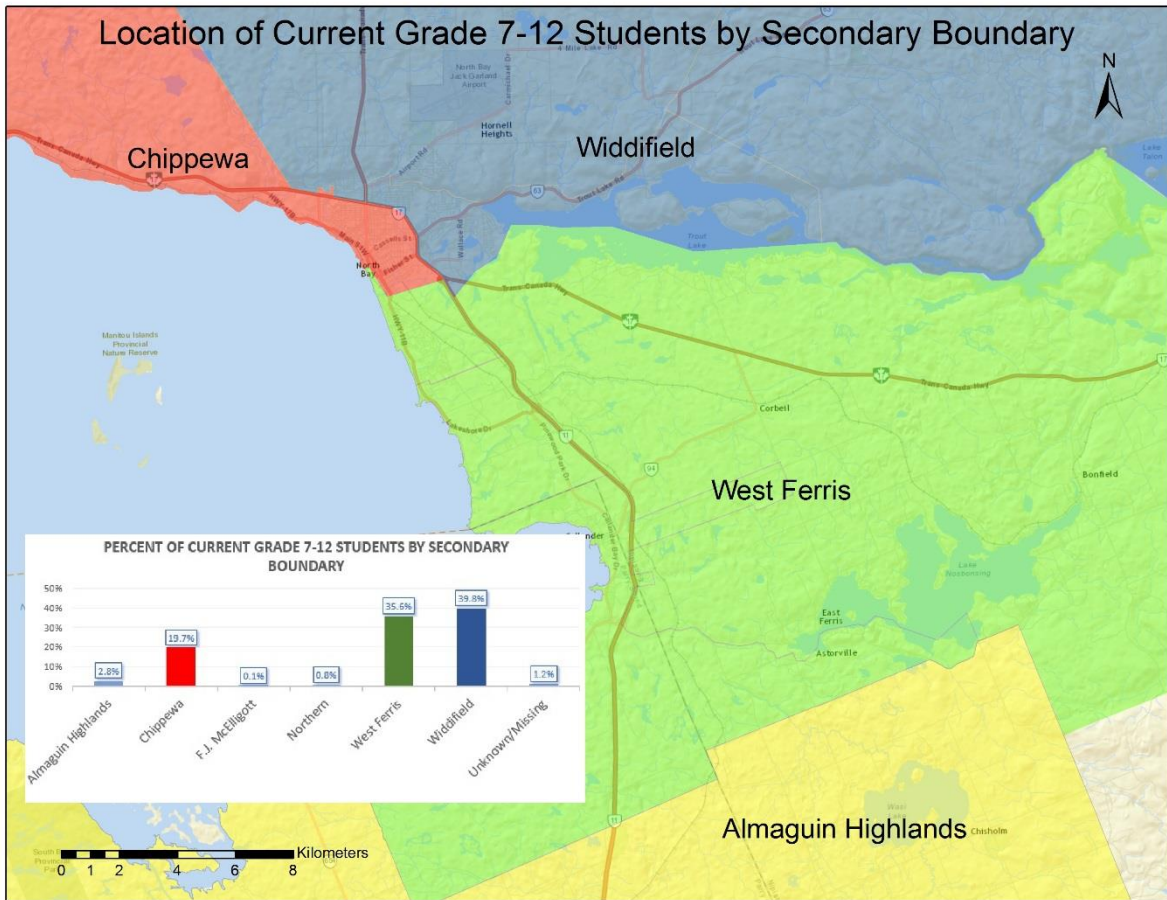
Second Scenario: Boundary Change

- Adjust school boundaries to evenly distribute all programs of grade 7 to 12 between Chippewa and West Ferris.

- To distribute all grade 7 to 12 students evenly between West Ferris and Chippewa, would require moving the north boundary of West Ferris into the Chippewa boundary.
- This boundary change would split graduating classes of students from Woodland and Alliance, as some students would attend West Ferris and some would attend Chippewa.
- Based on the current distribution of students between the three boundaries:
 - West Ferris 34.3%
 - Widdifield 39.8%
 - Chippewa 19.7%

The Chippewa population would need to be split with majority being redirected to West Ferris

Split of Chippewa Boundary:

- 63.9% of Chippewa boundary would attend West Ferris
- 36.1% of Chippewa boundary would remain at Chippewa
