Description of the school's suitability for facility partnerships:	This facility is at 70% utilization (2015-2016). By 2020-2021 Widdifield's utilization is projected to decrease to 46% which indicates that its underutilized space makes it conducive to be considered as a site with the potential space for a facility partnership. The potential for facility partnerships would be contingent upon many factors including the ability to identify and create a distinct space within the facility, separate from the students.
