NNDSB has begun a new initiative called Student Voice, with a goal of giving students in the system a platform to share their ideas and their work.

Any NNDSB student is able to contribute their work which will be posted on the NNDSB website and possibly on the board's social media accounts. To facilitate the collection of material in schools, Student Voice representatives are being sought in each school. The Student Voice reps will be working with staff at the school, as well as with the communications team at NNDSB's board office. This will require the use of the students' board email accounts.

In some cases, the Student Voice reps will be acting as school reporters, covering events at the school and taking photos for submission.

In order to participate, Student Voice representatives under the age of 18 must have this permission form signed by a parent/guardian. Students aged 18 and older do not require permission and may sign themselves.
