**Respect:** Students will learn self-respect and respect for others, as well as traditions, culture and sacred items.

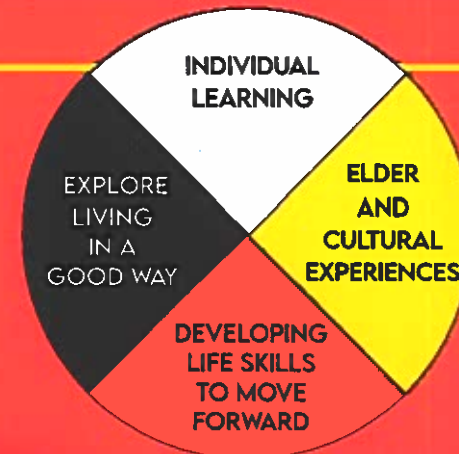
**Bravery:** Encouraged to work hard, and take chances, developed from working through obstacles, bravery comes from moving forward and working towards success.
