



Summer School Dual Credit

Dual Credits: one high school credit and one college course.

This program is primarily delivered using an experiential model, incorporating a combination of theory and hands-on outdoor experiences. Students can expect to spend part of each day outdoors.

Outdoor and Adventure Recreation – PLJ4T (College Course: REC260)

This course explores concepts and theories related to the development and delivery of outdoor recreation experiences. It examines both the adventure and environmental branches of outdoor recreation, as well as various therapeutic uses of the outdoors. Students will develop practical outdoor skills and participate in planning and facilitating outdoor experiences. Canadore's extensive trail network serves as an integral learning environment for on-site students.
